Raymond purchased Sixty Acres of land bounded and described as follows to wit: "beginning where the lower side of Pecan Street in said City crosses West Avenue and opposite the South East Corner of Lot No. 2, in Division 3. and a stake thence with the line of said Street, and westerly to Lot No. 2, in Division 3. until it intersects the N.E. Corner of Lot No. One in said Division thence S.E. with the line of said Lot No. One to its Corner on or near the bluff of the River Commons thence with the surroundings of said bluff including sixty yards below, to West Avenue near the Penitentiary Square, thence N.E. with said Avenue line to the beginning Corners" and has paid the full amount due on the same, amounting to One Hundred and Eighty Five Dollars: —
